## THIS MONTH IN U.S. AND NAVY HISTORY

- 8 November 1985 .....In a change of tradition, the rank of Commodore is changed to Rear Adm. Lower Half. The rank of Commodore had been in use since the beginning of the United States Navy.
- 10 November 1775 .....**MARINE CORPS BIRTHDAY** (249 years!)
- 11 November .....**VETERAN'S DAY**... In 1919, President Woodrow Wilson made November 11<sup>th</sup> a holiday to remember the end of World War I. The holiday was originally called Armistice Day. After US involvement in World War II and the Korean War, the name of the holiday was officially changed to Veterans Day to honor our veterans who served in all wars.
- 12 November 1942 .....The Naval battle of Guadalcanal begins with Japanese air attacks on U.S. ships bringing reinforcements to the embattled island. Over the next four days, Japan loses the battleships *Hiei* and *Kirishima*, heavy cruiser *Kinugasa*, three destroyers and many valuable transports. Two U.S. light cruisers, *Atlanta* and *Juneau*, and seven destroyers are sunk. Japan's losses weaken their ability to strengthen their garrison on Guadalcanal, enabling the U.S. to shift from the defensive to the offensive in this campaign.
- 13 November 2017 .....Retired Navy Capt. Thomas J. Hudner Jr., who earned the Medal of Honor during the Korean War, passes away. On Dec. 4, 1950, LTJG Hudner crashed his own plane in order to aid downed fellow aviator Ensign Jesse L. Brown, who had been shot down by enemy anti-aircraft fire. FYI... this is the plot of the 2022 movie, *Devotion*.
- 25 November 1961 .....*USS Enterprise* (CVAN 65), the U.S. Navy's first nuclear-powered aircraft carrier, is commissioned in Newport News, VA.
