

## THIS MONTH IN U.S. AND NAVY HISTORY

3 March 1969The Navy's Fighter Weapons School, also known as "Top Gun," is established.
5 March 1942The "Seabees" name and insignia are officially authorized. Rear Adm. Ben Moreell personally furnishes them
with their official motto: Construimus, Batuimus "We Build, We Fight."
10 March 2001USS Winston S. Churchill (DDG-81) is commissioned at Naval Station Norfolk. The 31st destroyer of
the Arleigh Burke class is the fourth U.S. Navy warship to be named after a British citizen. Churchill has a
Royal Navy officer assigned permanently to the ship and she flies the Royal Navy's White Ensign as well as the
Stars and Stripes.
17 March 1959USS <i>Skate</i> (SSN-578) becomes the first submarine to surface at the North Pole, traveling 3,000 miles in and under Arctic ice for more than a month.
25 MarchCongress designates March 25 each year as National Medal of Honor Day. The day is significant as it is the
day the first Medal of Honor was presented in 1863.
